



Service Academy Nomination Instructions

Please carefully read directions. Incomplete or incorrectly submitted applications will not be processed.

- Formal candidacy will only be established upon the receipt of a fully completed application for nomination, due **Friday, November 7, 2025**. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Applications must be submitted as a complete packet with all required materials included. The application should be secured with a paper clip or binder clip and submitted in a file folder or manila envelope. Do not staple any portions of the application.
- Please remember that applying to an academy and applying to your Member of Congress for a nomination are two separate processes. It is your responsibility to initiate a pre-candidate file at all academies to which you are seeking a nomination.

Required Application Materials

1. **Photograph:** Please email a recent headshot in JPEG format to Jessica.Hayes1@mail.house.gov.
2. **Academic Transcript:** High school transcripts must be official and sealed. If you have already graduated high school, an official transcript is still required.
3. **Standardized Test Scores (SAT/ACT):**
 - If your SAT or ACT scores are not included with your official transcript, you may print them directly from the test websites and include them with your application.
 - Please do not request official score reports to be sent directly to us from SAT or ACT.
4. **Candidate Fitness Assessment (CFA):**
 - Submit a copy of your completed CFA (either the included form or one obtained from the academy).
 - If you took the CFA during Summer Seminar, please have your academy representative email a copy to Jessica.Hayes1@mail.house.gov.
 - Instructions for completing the CFA may be found on each academy's website.
5. **Personal Recommendation Forms:**
 - Submit three personal recommendations completed by individuals who know you well, such as counselors, teachers, coaches, religious leaders, or community leaders.
 - All references should be from non-family members.
